

LP4Y's mission

In the world today, there are about 1.2 billion young people aged between 15 and 24, 550 million out of them suffer from malnutrition, illness and violence. It is calculated that in 2025, 1 billion young people will be living below the poverty threshold of 1.9 USD / day. In this situation, women are exposed to risks of prostitution, sexual abuses, early marriage, early births and exploitation at work...

In response to this desperate situation, the "Life Project 4 Youth" was created. This is an organization dedicating to the integration of young adults living in extreme poverty and exclusion, to accompany them towards social integration and professional inclusion.

LP4Y has set up entrepreneurial development centers known as « Life Project Centers» (LPCs), where young adults commit as team members to join the "Professional Training for Entrepreneurs" (PTE) for around 18 months.

During this PTE, the young adults experience the creation, development and management of a

micro-economic activity, which teaches them to take initiatives, hold responsibilities and become professional. They also catch up on their education, receive English, IT and other general knowledge, and are coached to improve their personal skills and build their Life Project Plan.

Since its creation in 2009, 996 young people have been accompanied.

LP4Y settled in Vietnam in 2014 and opened 3 centers in Hanoi and HCM City. More than 170 young people have already been accompanied.

In these centers, young women can prepare themselves to enter the professional world as strong women, ready to face difficulties, work hard for their dreams, and bring their energy, talent and creativity to companies where they work.

Indeed, young people facing extreme poverty are capable of becoming great entrepreneurs if someone gives them a smile, a supporting word, room to grow and trust.
